- *5. Demonstrate proficiency in the six fundamental movement skills as measured by the South Carolina Assessment criteria.
6. Teacher candidates must successfully complete BIOL307 before admission to Teacher Education will be granted.

Before enrolling in EDUC 475 and 490, teacher candidates must:

1. Achieve a "C" or better in PHED 348 and PHED 391.
2. Pass Praxis II (both content and video portion).
